This show will be held January 10-16th, 2012 in the Community Arts Center Building at 86 S. Main, St. George, Utah. At this time the building will also be filled with art, artists, live demos, workshops, and lectures to celebrate St. George's rich, artistic heritage.

Entries will be juried for quality and best use of theme. Open to all Medias including, but not limited to, painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, fiber arts, pottery, glass, print making.

\$5 entry fee, one piece per person maximum. No entry fee for paid VAA members or children 3-18 years old. 20% commission will be retained on all pieces sold during the duration of the show.

Pieces shall be original works. Pieces shall not exceed 3' X3' framed. Pieces shall be matted or framed and ready for hanging with wire.

Pieces shall be dropped off for jury at the Community Arts Center Building at 86 S. Main, St. George on Saturday, January 7th, between 10am-12pm. Pick up will be Tuesday, January 17th, between 3-7pm.

Prizes and awards, including a City of St. George purchase prize and Viewer's Choice Awards will be awarded. Judging will be based on the marriage of artistic quality with best, most creative exploration of the theme, “A Desert To A Dream”.
